Dear cadets and parents/guardians,

Next weekend, (May 19th to 22nd), 577 RCACS will be conducting a joint field training exercise with 2850 Army Cadets from Grande Prairie and 2638 Army Cadets from Hinton. This event will take place at Camp Hideaway, south of Grande Cache, AB. Cadets will be taking part in a variety of outdoor activities, including survival training, navigation and canoeing.

Cadets were invited to sign up for this activity in March. Only cadets that signed up are permitted to attend, as bussing was booked for that number of cadets. If you are unsure if your cadet is signed up, a list will be posted on the bulletin board in the armouries.

Cadets will be required to be at the D Coy Armouries at 9:00 am on Friday May 19th, and will be returning at approximately 5:30 pm on Sunday May 22nd. There is a kit list attached to this letter detailing what cadets are to pack. Cadet's kit will be inspected prior to leaving Grande Prairie in order to ensure cadets have the essentials packed and to ensure nothing unsafe is being brought on the exercise.

As we are all aware, Alberta is currently experiencing an unprecedented wildfire season. It is currently uncertain if this will impact our ability to conduct this exercise. The decision whether or not to proceed with the exercise will be made by next Tuesday (May 16th). This decision will be made with the safety of our cadets foremost in mind and will not be taken lightly.
