Dear Cadets and Parents/Guardians,

**On the weekend of October 5 and 6**, 577 will be taking part in our Fall Field Training Exercise (FTX) held at Camp Wapiti (south of Grande Prairie). This activity will be hosted over the entire weekend with an overnight stay at the camp. Parental drop off and pick up will be required at the camp entrance at the start and end of the activity. Drop off times will be **0800hrs on Saturday Oct 5th and pick up will be at 1600hrs on Sunday Oct 6th**. Cadets are to be dropped off already eaten breakfast and with a full water bottle, along with all their other equipment from the kit list below.

The dress for the activity will be FTU's with a cadet issued tilly hat or an appropriate civilian ball cap. Cadets who have not been issued FTUs yet are to wear appropriate civilian clothing. Cadets should be prepared for various weather conditions, including rain and heat on the same day. Layers are important civilian jackets, and outer wear is approved with FTUs for weather related concerns. A small backpack is recommended to carry extra layers and items during the day. Cadets will be given lunch each day and dinner/breakfast during the activity, with various fresh snacks given throughout the weekend. A map to the camp (directions are based on travel from the D-Coy Armouries) and kit list for the activity is attached below this letter.
