#### Dear Cadets and Parents/Guardians,

From 16-19 May, 2025, 577 Squadron will be hosting our Spring Field Training Exercise (FTX) at Camp Hide-A-Way, located just outside Grande Cache, AB. This exciting multi-day, overnight training event will involve cadets from three units, offering valuable learning opportunities and outdoor experiences. As this activity is taking place outside of Grande Prairie and spans several days, it is vital that all cadets are fully prepared and follow the attached kit list closely.

Cadets will travel to the camp by **bus**, departing from **D Coy Armouries**. **Drop-off time**: No later than **5:30 PM Friday 16 May. Departure time**: **6:00 PM sharp.** Cadets should **arrive having already eaten dinner** or bring a **packed meal**. A **filled water bottle** is also required, along with all necessary items from the kit list. Kit will be checked by staff to ensure appropriate items are being brought and any prohibited items are removed. Cadets are to travel in civilian attire.

Dress for the weekend is FTUs with a cadet-issued Tilley hat or an appropriate civilian ball cap during training activities. Cadets who have not yet been issued FTUs may wear appropriate civilian outdoor clothing. Weather conditions may vary throughout the weekend (rain, sun, heat), so layering is essential. Civilian jackets and outerwear are permitted with FTUs for weather-related comfort. A small backpack is recommended for carrying layers, water, and personal items during daily activities. Cadets will change into civilian attire in the evenings when training is over to allow for more comfort and avoid any hygiene concerns with the longer activity. Please see the kit list attached to the back of this letter for specifics.

Only cadets who **pre-registered** for this activity will be attending, due to planning requirements.
